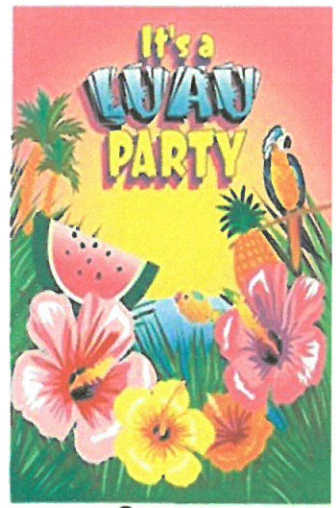

Dear Cypress Trail Homeowners,

This letter is to acquaint you with the Heritage Memorial Garden project that we have undertaken at Cypress Trail RV Park. About twenty interested homeowners formed a committee in January of 2017 to create a plan that would not only provide a quiet place for individual meditation, reflection and inspiration, but would also be an attractive and unique place with water features and plants that would attract birds and butterflies.

We are fortunate to have numerous volunteers here in the park who have shared various types of expertise in this endeavor. Fund raising has included donations made by individuals, as well as contributions made by the Saturday morning breakfast committee, the Cypress Trail Quilters, numerous \$500 referral donations from lot transactions, as well as a sizable contribution from the developer of the resort. Materials and services have also been donated by various vendors.

Heritage Memorial Garden is a work in progress. Construction began, in December 2017, with pouring of the concrete pathway. In January 2018, twenty homeowner volunteers moved 60 yards of dirt into the garden to level it and prepare it for planting. February has been a month of planting more than 125 plants, bushes and trees. Installation of the irrigation system has begun, as well. Water fountains, bird baths and several benches have been purchased and placed in the garden.

Many elements of the garden remain to be completed such as construction of the arbor at the entrance, planting of the interior gardens, completion of the irrigation system, development of privacy seating areas, and some sort of decorative groundcover.

There are various opportunities for volunteering in order to bring this garden to fruition. Volunteers are always needed to help with various projects. We are grateful for financial contributions, too, of course. Checks are made payable to Pam Hamilton, with memo to Heritage Memorial Garden. Donations can be placed in the receptacle on the counter in the office. Your participation is welcomed and appreciated.
